Chimay White / Belgium / 11 - fruity notes of muscat and raisins provide a deep finish.

Firestone Pale Ale / United States / 6 – the classic British Pale Ale elevated with Northwest American hops.

Firestone Velvet Merlin / United States / 6 – coffee, bittersweet chocolate some raisin. simply beautiful.

Guinness / Ireland / 6 - the result of a stirring tale of inspiration and dedication. .

Hitachino Belgian White / Japan / 9 - lemon tartness with hints of coriander.

Old Speckled Hen / United Kingdom / 6.5 - fine ale brewed to celebrate the 50th anniversary of a MG car factory.

Pabst Blue Ribbon / United States / 5 – the blue collar American beer.

Stella Artois / Belgium / 5.5 – a refreshing bottom-fermented blond pilsner.

BOTTLES AND CANS

Lagers:

Amstel Light / Holland / 4.5 - mildly bitter taste with cheerful character.

Budweiser / Bud Light / United States / 3.5 – a “perfect” balance of all natural ingredients.

Czechvar / Czech Republic / 5.5 - the original Budweiser.

Flying Horse / India / 10.5 (22oz.) – sweetness is well balanced by crisp bitter finish

Heineken / Holland / 4.5 – fruity yeast aroma with a mildly bitter taste.

Kronenberg / France / 5 – more bitter than sweet, with citrus flavors reminiscent of grapefruit.

Moretti / Italy / 6 – Italy’s favorite export.

Red Stripe / Jamaica / 4.5 - hints of butterscotch smooth in post-palate sensation.

Sapporo / Japan / 5.5 - refreshing flavor and moderately light body.

Singha / Thailand / 5 - a hoppy, grainy complexity that’s supremely fresh.

Tsingtao / China / 4 - malty flavor with a nutty sweet taste.

Non-Alcohol:

Kaliber (Non-Alcohol) / United Kingdom / 4 - delivers all the taste of a great beer.

Hefeweizens:

Hacker Pschorr Weisse / Germany / 8 (500ml) – a mildly fruity taste with cloudy color.

Paulaner Hefe Weizen / Germany / 6 – full of clove, vanilla, fruit, honey and banana overtones.

Paulaner Salvator Doppelbock / Germany / 5.5 – toffee, raisins, and caramel with a citrus finish.

Schneider Aventinus Weizenbock / Germany / 12 (500ml) – clove like aroma with hints of caramel

Schneider Hopfen Weiss / Germany / 12 (500ml) - hoppy, zesty and supremely refreshing.

Ales:

Abita Purple Haze / United States / 6 – American style wheat beer with raspberry puree added.

Allagash Black / United States / 18 (750ml) – toasty smell that tastes of chocolate, oats and bits of citrus.

Brasserie Des Rocs Grand Cru / Belgium / 10 – a lot of dark fruits with hints of almond on the finish.

Chimay Blue / Belgium / 11 - the fragrance of fresh yeast with a light rosy touch.

Chimay Red / Belgium / 11 – creamy head, apricot aroma and a light touch of bitterness.

Delirium Nocturnum / Belgium / 18 (750ml) - raisins, bittersweet chocolate and aniseed.

Fischer Amber Ale / France / 6 – lemongrass aroma with hints of soft caramel.

Firestone Union Jack / United States / 5.5 – an aggressive IPA with citrus, pineapple and full chewy malt finish.

Flying Dog Doggie Style / United States / 6 – dry hopped with an unrivaled hop flavor and aroma.

Flying Dog Raging Bitch IPA / United States / 5 – burst of fruit, spice and yeast followed by candied sugar.

Green Flash Hop Head Red / United States / 5.5 – strong hop character with a caramel malt base.

Grimbergen Blond / Belgium / 7 – a nose of lemon behind a nutty banana scent.

Hitachino Nestbeer Red Rice / Japan / 10 – fresh with plums and hints of strawberry.

Red Nectar Ale / United States / 5 – accents of toasted malt, caramel and spice.

Val-Dieu Triple / Belgium / 18 (750ml) – hints of pears and pineapple with spicy booze finish.

Dark / Stouts:

Anchor Porter / United States / 5.5 - thick creamy head and rich flavor.

Anderson Valley Oatmeal Stout / United States / 5.5 – full-bodied with mocha characters.

Meantime London Porter / United Kingdom / 18 (750ml) –nutty and roasty with strawberry tartness.

Old Rasputin Imperial Stout / United States / 5.5 – richly intense with big complex flavors and warm finish.

Spaten Optimator / Germany / 5.5 – deep and dark in color with a rich roasted malt flavor.

Young's Double Chocolate Stout / United Kingdom / 11 – very strong chocolate (duh!) with a tiny coffee finish.
